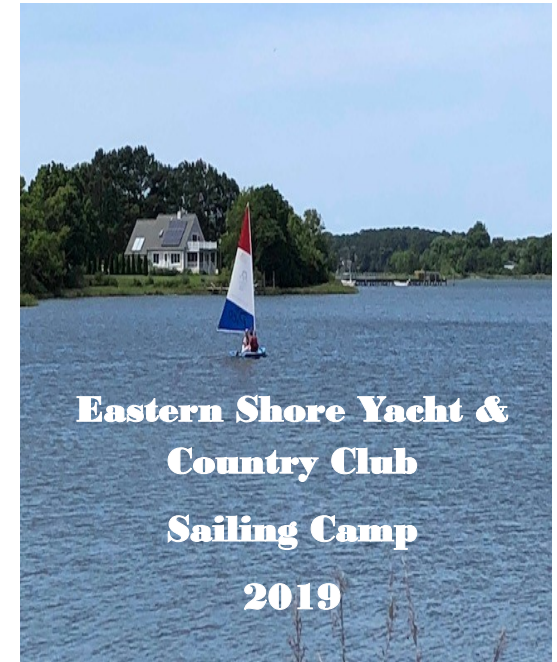
Yacht Club and the Augusta Sailing Club, and is a U.S. Sailing certified instructor.
