

# Privacy Policy

Thank you for choosing to be part of our community at Nick & Mike Bar and Grill ("company", "we", "us", or "our"). We are committed to protecting your personal information and your right to privacy. When you visit our website and use our services, you trust us with your personal information. We take your privacy very seriously. In this privacy notice, we describe our privacy policy. We seek to explain to you in the clearest way possible what information we collect, how we use it and what rights you have in relation to it. We hope you take some time to read through it carefully, as it is important. If there are any terms in this privacy policy that you do not agree with, please discontinue use of our site and our services.

This privacy policy applies to all information collected through our website or mobile application, and/or any related services, sales, marketing or events (we refer to them collectively in this privacy policy as the "Site").

**Please read this privacy policy carefully as it will help you make informed decisions about sharing your personal information with us.**

## WHAT INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT?

### Personal information you disclose to us

***In Short:*** We collect personal information that you provide to us such as name and contact information.

We collect personal information that you voluntarily provide to us when registering for communication with us, expressing an interest in obtaining information about us or our products and services, when participating in activities on the Site or otherwise contacting us.

### **Information automatically collected**

***In Short:*** *Some information – such as IP address and/or browser and device characteristics – is collected automatically when you visit our website.*

We automatically collect certain information when you visit, use or navigate the Site. This information does not reveal your specific identity (like your name or contact information) but may include device and usage information, such as your IP address, browser and device characteristics, operating system, language preferences, referring URLs, device name, country, location, information about how and when you use our Site and other technical information. If you access our site with your mobile device, we may automatically collect device information (such as your mobile device ID, model and manufacturer), operating system, version information and IP address. This information is primarily needed to maintain the security and operation of our Site, and for our internal analytics and reporting purposes.

Like many businesses, we also collect information through cookies and similar technologies. You can find out more about this in our cookie policy.

## **Information collected from other Sources**

***In Short:*** *We may collect limited data from public databases, marketing partners, social media platforms, and other outside sources.*

We may obtain information about you *generally* from other sources, such as public databases, joint marketing partners, social media platforms (such as Facebook), as well as from other third parties.

## **HOW DO WE USE YOUR INFORMATION?**

***In Short:*** *We process your information for purposes based on legitimate business interests, the fulfillment of our contract with you, compliance with our legal obligations, and/or your consent.*

We use personal information collected via our Site for a variety of business purposes. We process your personal information for these business purposes in reliance of our legitimate business interests (“Business Purposes”), in order to perform services for you with your consent (“Consent”). We may use information

that you provide for data analysis, identifying usage trends, determining the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns and to evaluate and improve our Site, products, services, marketing and your experience.

## WILL YOUR INFORMATION BE SHARED WITH ANYONE?

***In Short:*** *We only share information with your consent, to comply with laws, to protect your rights, or to fulfill business obligations.*

We only share and disclose your information in the following situations:

- **Compliance with Laws.** We may disclose your information where we are legally required to do so in order to comply with applicable law, governmental requests, a judicial proceeding, court order, or legal process, such as in response to a court order or a subpoena (including in response to public authorities to meet national security or law enforcement requirements).
- **Vital Interests and Legal Rights.** We may disclose your information where we believe it is necessary to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding potential violations of our policies, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the safety of any person and illegal activities, or as evidence in litigation in which we are involved.
- **Vendors, Consultants and Other Third-Party Service Providers.** We may share your data with third party vendors, service providers, contractors or agents who perform services for us or on our behalf and require access to such information to do that work. Examples include: payment processing, data analysis, email delivery, hosting services, customer service and professional marketing efforts. We may allow selected third parties to use tracking technology on the Site, which will enable them to collect data about how you interact with the Site over time. This information may be used to, among other things, analyze and track data, determine the popularity of certain content and better understand online activity. Unless described in this Policy, we do not share, sell, rent or trade any of your information with third parties for their promotional purposes.

- **With your Consent.** We may disclose your personal information for any other purpose with your consent.
- **Other Users.** When you share personal information (for example, by posting comments, contributions or other content to the Site) or otherwise interact with public areas of the Site, such personal information may be viewed by all users and may be publicly distributed outside the Site in perpetuity.

## DO WE USE COOKIES AND OTHER TRACKING TECHNOLOGIES?

***In Short:** We may use cookies and other tracking technologies to collect and store your information.*

We may use cookies and similar tracking technologies (like web beacons and pixels) to access or store information. Specific information about how we use such technologies and how you can refuse certain cookies is set out in our cookie policy.

## IS YOUR INFORMATION TRANSFERRED INTERNATIONALLY?

***In Short:** We only transfer, store, and process your information in the United States.*

Our servers are located in the United States. If you are a resident in the European Economic Area, then these countries may not have data protection or other laws as comprehensive as those in your country. We will however take all necessary measures to protect your personal information in accordance with this privacy policy and applicable law.

## HOW LONG DO WE KEEP YOUR INFORMATION?

***In Short:*** We keep your information for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this privacy policy unless otherwise required by law.

We will only keep your personal information for as long as it is necessary for the purposes set out in this privacy policy, unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by law (such as tax, accounting or other legal requirements). No purpose in this policy will require us keeping your personal information for a term any longer than outlined herein.

When we have no ongoing legitimate business need to process your personal information, we will either delete or anonymize it, or, if this is not possible (for example, because your personal information has been stored in backup archives), then we will securely store your personal information and isolate it from any further processing until deletion is possible.

## HOW DO WE KEEP YOUR INFORMATION SAFE?

***In Short:*** We aim to protect your personal information through a system of organizational and technical security measures.

We have implemented appropriate technical and organizational security measures designed to protect the security of any personal information we process. However, please also remember that we cannot guarantee that the internet itself is 100% secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal information, transmission of personal information to and from our Site is at your own risk. You should only access the services within a secure environment.

## DO WE COLLECT INFORMATION FROM MINORS?

***In Short:*** We do not knowingly collect data from or market to persons under 21 years of age.

We do not knowingly solicit data from or market to children under 21 years of age. By using the Site, you represent that you are at least 21 or that you are the parent or guardian of such a minor and consent to such minor dependent's use of the Site. If we learn that personal information from users less than 21 years of age has been collected, we will deactivate the account and take reasonable measures to promptly delete such data from our records. ## DO WE RESPOND TO DO-NOT-TRACK SIGNALS?

No uniform technology standard for recognizing and implementing DNT signals has been finalized.
