We are sure you have read about the new Fairfax County ordinance subjecting consumers who use disposable plastic bags to a five-cent tax. We encourage our guests to substitute reusable shopping bags for plastic bags. Starting January 1 The Main Street Pub plans to use brown craft bags instead of disposable plastic bags. We made the decision not to continue using disposable plastic bags because of the compliance burden placed on businesses. For the month of January if you bring your own bag – or don't need a bag – we will discount your entire food order by five percent. This is to encourage our guests to substitute reusable shopping bags during the transition to the new system. However, starting February 1 we will charge twenty-five cents to guests who request a brown paper bag when picking up their food orders. We are not making a profit—the twenty-five-cent charge covers our cost for each bag. Again, we made the decision not to continue using disposable plastic bags because of the compliance burden placed on businesses.
