



COVID-19 Practices

Updated: August 27, 2020

Under the guidance of the Lambton Public Health Unit and all levels of government we will continue to monitor these practices. The health and safety of our guests and staff is our top priority.

We ask all guests to remain 2 metres (6 feet) apart from other guests and staff whenever possible. Please adhere to all the protocols and procedures. Follow physical distancing floor markers and arrows.

Sanitize your hands upon entry and exit. Hand sanitizer is also available throughout the facility. We require contact tracing information (name and phone number) by one of the guests in your group.

When signing up for bowling, staff will provide you with rental shoes and house balls.

When finished bowling please leave house balls on the lane. Please return rental shoes to the designated totes by the front desk. After each use house balls and rental shoes are disinfected.

Groups will be spaced out with lanes not in use between groups.

After each group staff will sanitize ball racks, score stands, seating, tables and chairs. All high traffic areas including washrooms and door handles are sanitized on an hourly schedule.

Masks: The Village Of Point Edward passed a bylaw requiring masks to be worn within an enclosed public place for ages 9 and up. Masks/face coverings are required for ages 9 and up at all times except when seated at tables while eating/drinking or up on the lane while bowling.

Our capacity is reduced to 50 patrons for bowling areas and 42 patrons for the restaurant. All tables and seating areas have been arranged to allow for proper distancing. We ask our guests not to move tables and chairs.
