We still have gas. But the gas folks say it's too cold to be out on the water.

What Is Winterizing?

Before the mercury dips below freezing, you need to prepare your boat for the coming winter. At its most basic, winterizing means draining any water aboard or replacing it with enough of the right kind of antifreeze to protect against the lowest temperatures your boat might experience. Freshwater expands in volume by about 9% when it freezes and can push outward with a force of tens of thousands of pounds per square inch. That expansion can crack an

engine block, damage fiberglass, split hoses, or destroy a refrigeration system overnight.
