## **GAS GOSSIP**

Not much new in away of fuels. With spring upon us we will start getting busier.

Remember to get your TOCO Fuel Card for the 2020 Boating Season!

Boat US has some ideas about how to get your fuel system ready for spring:

Check the fuel system. Inspect fuel lines, including fill and vent hoses, for indications of softness, brittleness, or cracking. Any that are suspect should be replaced with U.S. Coast Guard-approved A1- or A15-certified fuel hose. Fuel hoses for gasoline should be double clamped. Pay attention to fuel-line fittings, too — another source of dangerous leaks. Use your finger and look for stains and fuel smells under or around the fitting.

### **Taylor Oil Company (TOCO) FUEL CARDS**

As always, if you do not already have one they are worth taking the time to sign up. You can gas up 24/7 at WYC. If the clubs closed this is your only way to get fuel! Here is the link to the application.
